BLAYE CÔTES DE BORDEAUX

Village : Cars

Total surface of the vineyard : 23 hectares

Type of soils : Primarily clay limestone soils followed by sandy clay and red clay soils

Blend of grape varieties : 75 % Merlot, 15 % Malbec and 10 % Cabernet Sauvignon

Wine vinification : Yeasting, pumping over and delestage adapted to suit the structure of the wine. Full control of temperatures. Three weeks' fermentation. Aged in stainless steel vats.

Tasting notes : Purple in colour, it opens with generous notes of fresh summer berries on the nose. The mouth is rich with powerful tannins that fade into aromas of very ripe redcurrants. As a whole it is perfectly balanced and lively with marked sweetness. An accomplished, classic style that highlights the appellation's finest terroirs.
