Village : Marcillac

Total surface of the vineyard : 22.5 hectares

Type of soils : Sandy gravel

Blend of grape varieties : 70 % Merlot, 25 % Cabernet Sauvignon and 5 % Cabernet Franc

Wine vinification : Pumping over and delestage during alcoholic fermentation, perfect control of temperatures. Racking after malolactic fermentation followed by aging in concrete vats.

Tasting notes : The garnet colour is still young. The pleasing nose offers a delicate combination of fruity and floral notes. On the palate, the fine attack full of sap and great freshness blends with distinctive, mouth-watering tannins evoking liquorice. A very harmonious and aromatic Bordeaux.
