


Vineyard owned by the Faux Family since 1886 (5th generation). Farmer Bousseau family.

Village: Prignac et Marcamps

Total surface area of vineyard: 10 hectares

**Soil type :** Clay and limestone

**Blend of grapes**: 80% Merlot and 20% Cabernet Sauvignon **Vinification and maturing**: Stainless steel vats, long maceration. **Tasting notes**: The colour is deep and intense, the nose opens with crisp fruit and the direct attack on the palate leads into notes of fresh herbs and tart red fruit. Hints of roasted woodiness burst through, extending into the finish.
