My parents had owned the estate since 1981 and planted the whole vineyard. Their skills were very traditional: my father even aged his wines in huge barrels called foudres. After taking over, we have expanded and modernised the estate. Today it covers 38 hectares and we have set up our storage and vinification cellars there.

Total surface of the vineyard : 13 hectares Type of soils : Calcareous clay and sandy Blend of grape varieties : 85% Merlot and 15% Cabernet Sauvignon Wine vinification : Cold maceration for 3-4 days prior to fermentation. Turbo-punching of the cap for gentle extraction. Length of maceration adapted according to the year. Aged in cement and stainless steel vats. Tasting notes : Purple and deep colour. It opens on some aromas of cruching fruit with some blackcurrant and well melted oak. Straight and powerful with a lot of fruits on the palate. Finish of ripe fruits and spice. A traditional and pleasant style.
