BLAYE CÔTES DE BORDEAUX

Village: Cars

Terroir: Soil of clay-limestone - South-West sun exposed slopes - 40-year-old vines

Winemaking and ageing: Mechanical harvest at the end of september. Traditional winemaking : yeasting, pumping-over and delestage, depending on the wine structure. Temperature regulation. Three-week fermentation. Ageing in stainless steel vats with wood input.

Blend: 100% Merlot

Tasting comments: The colour is deep. The fragrance opens with liquorice notes. The palate is dense with ripe and soft tanins thanks to a good maturity. The whole is round with poise.

Food and wine pairings: Stuffed quail, Stew
